### **Preamble**

Established in the Year 1956 Indira Kala Sangit Vishwavidyalaya (IKSV) is situated in Khairagarh town of Chhattisgarh State of India. It is a university with difference where higher education is imparted in Music, Dance, Fine Arts and Theatre. Honourable Governor of the Chhattisgarh State is the Chancellor and Administrative cum Academic Head of I.K.S.V. Khairagarh.

The then rulers of princely state of Khairagarh, Raja Virendra Bahadur Singh and Rani Padmavati Devi Singh donated their ancestral palace to establish a University of Music & Fine Arts as a tribute to their daughter Princess 'INDIRA'. The generous support and donations from the then rulers of Khairagarh, an ardent lovers of music and fine arts provided requisite inspiration and vision. The palace donated by them houses the foremost portion of the University, which is now one of the best examples of amalgamated architectural style.

University was inaugurated on 14th October, 1956 by Smt. Indira Gandhi, the daughter of then the Prime Minister of India Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru. IKSV takes pride in being Asia's first University dedicated to various forms of Music, Dance, Fine Arts and Theatre. This institution is actively engaged in pursuing artistic, academic and cultural goals at a time when music and fine arts is undergoing through rapid change and is exposed to globalization.

Since its inception University is making efforts for preservation and propagation of holistic knowledge in the field of Music and Fine Arts. It is first and only university in India which is represented as a State Tableau during Republic Day parade, New Delhi. The sincere effort of the University has been acknowledged by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore and after assessment in the Year 2014, Indira Kala Sangit Vishwavidyalaya, Khairagarh was accredited with Grade 'A'. This achievement of the University has also added another jewel in the crown by becoming the First University in Chhattisgarh State which was accredited as Grade 'A' university by NAAC.

The University consists of five different faculties encapsulated, with various associated departments, affiliated colleges, examination centres and several other units. This University conducts teaching and research programmes in the very distinct field of Indian Music, Dance, Theatre & Visual Art forms.

Here at IKSV, efforts are made to balance the vacillating scale of traditionalism and modernism. This University is constantly trying to make music and fine arts vibrant and economically viable.

The objective of the University is "to provide instructions in all branches of music and fine arts, to make provision for research and advancement of studies in music and fine arts and dissemination of knowledge their off."

### **Academic Session**

Academic Session 2023-24 of Indira Kala Sangit Vishwavidyalaya, Khairagarh will commence from 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2023.

### Location

Amidst rich rural and tribal setting-away from din and bustle of urban area, ideal for the Cultivation of art sense-Khairagarh is situated in the central part of India and comes under the Khairagarh-Chhuikhadan-Gandai District of Chhattisgarh State. It is also known for its vivid architectural wonders and rich cultural heritage.

### Railway

The three nearby railway stations Rajnandgaon, Dongargarh and Durg are at a distance 40, 42 and 55 Kms from Khairagarh respectively. Direct trains for New Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and Chennai are available from these three Railway Stations, situated on the main train route of Howrah-Mumbai via Nagpur.

### **Faculty of Music**

### **Department of Vocal Music**



The Department was established in the year 1956 and is engaged in teaching different styles of Hindustani Vocal Music. Department primarily offers Under Graduate B.P.A. and Postgraduate M. P. A. programmes. Department also runs various diploma courses especially to motivate young budding artist and school kids towards music. Diploma courses of eight years in classical vocal from Prathama to Kovid and a two year light music Diploma course, called Geetanjali (Junior & Senior) are also available for music learners. Apart from the above, the department also provides research opportunities in the field of Music through Ph. D. and D. Lit. Programmes.

### **Department of String Instruments**

The Department offers teaching in Violin (Hindustani), Sitar and Sarod. Department provides Under Graduate and Postgraduate programmes. Researchers are encouraged through Ph. D. and D. Lit. Programmes. The department also offers various diploma programmes viz. Prathama, Madhayama, and Vid & Kovid to generate interest among the upcoming artists towards String Instruments.



### **Department of Percussion Instruments**



Established in the Year 1994, Department of Percussion is engaged in teaching, learning and accommodating research work in Tabla and other percussion instruments. The courses have been designed to facilitate elaborate training and extensive exposure to the students. The aim is to produce good music educators cum performers. Under Graduate B.P.A., Postgraduate M.P.A. and different levels of diploma courses Prathama, Madhayama, Vid & Kovid are offered to fulfil the requirements of the students. Apart from the above, department also provides research opportunities in the field of music through Ph. D. and D. Lit. programmes.

### **Department of Carnatic Music**

Department was established in the Year 2012 with the objective of providing facility to learn South Indian Music to all the students. This department offers Under Graduate and Post graduate courses in Carnatic Vocal and Violin. Research opportunities are made available through Ph. D. and D. Lit. programmes. Apart from this the department also provides training through various Diploma Programmes viz. Prathama, Madhyama, Vid and Kovid.



### **Department of Physics of Sound**



The department basically supports the students of music for a part of their studies in music theory. The department is well equipped with audiovisual recording equipments. The Department is introducing a new course of one year Diploma in sound Recording and Re-production from the present Academic session.

### **Faculty of Dance**

### **Department of Kathak Dance**

Established in the year 1956, the Department of Kathak Dance is one of the oldest Departments of the University. Kathak is known as one of the most expressive dance forms of India. Kathak dance is known for its vivid expressions and unique language. The department offers Under Graduate B.P.A. programmes and Postgraduate M. P. A. Programme. Department also promotes research through Ph. D. and D. Lit. programmes. The department also nurtures creativity by introductory dance training facility for the young children through its various Diploma level programmes Prathama, Madhayama, Vid & Kovid



The Department also works for the preservation & enhancement of the art of Kathak dance style and thus enriching the cultural heritage of India, zwhich will promote a better understanding of Indian values in the new generation.

### Department of Bharathanatyam Dance



Since the year of its establishment in the year 1971, the department of Bharatanatyam has been gradually progressing. The first student of the dept. passed from its affiliated college in Bhopal and is today amongst famous artists in India and abroad. Since then, many of its students have received National Scholarships, cleared the NET examination and have also been placed in various schools, colleges and universities while others are running their own institutions. At present the department offers Under Graduate course BPA of 4 years and Post Graduate course M.P.A. of 2 years. Along with a Diploma course of 8 years. (Prathama, Madhyama,

Vid, Kovid) specialized to provide training to young children. After a pause the dept has once again started research activities and the research scholars of the dept. are working towards their Ph. D's. The teaching is imparted in both Hindi and English language for easy understanding of the students and both the theoretical and practical aspects of dance remain the main focus of the study. The aim of the department is to popularize this South Indian art form in the North region, to produce talented and efficient new generations of artists, teachers and choreographers who will not only preserve the ageold traditional values and ethics of Bharatanatyam but also incorporate the new methodologies of the current times so as to establish this dance form to the newest heights of achievement.

### **Department of Odissi Dance**



Established in the year 2013, under the Faculty of Dance, the Odissi Department is at present running Under Graduate programme B.P.A. of four years, Post Graduate MPA programme of two years and Diploma Course Prathama, Madhayama, Vid & Kovid. The focus of this department is towards preservation and promotion of this traditional art form of the temples of Odisha in the central India.

### Faculty of Folk Music & Art

### Department of Folk Music

Department of Folk Music was established in the year 1978. In the year 1984, the department was converted into a full-fledged faculty named as Faculty of Folk Music and Art. The faculty works to promote, preserve and propagate Folk music and art of the remote areas in its original form.

The department is actively engaged in teaching and research of different Indian folk traditions with an emphasis on various folk dance forms. Under Graduate B.P.A. and Postgraduate M. P. A. programmes are running in the department.



Department also offers Ph. D. and D. Lit. programmes. It also offer Six months Certificate Course and One & Two years Diploma courses. The Department is introducing a new course of one year Diploma in Tribal Music and Dance from the present Academic session.



### **Faculty of Visual Arts**

### **Department of Painting**



Established in the Year 1973, the Department of Painting provides learning on aesthetic principles and creative aspects of painting. The budding artists give new dimensions to their artistic creativity through training imparted by the experienced teachers of the department. The teachers of the department emphasize on study of nature and small & simple things of day to day life which drives students to take landscape trips and sketching trips to nearby places.

The students trained by the department are not only earning name in the contemporary field of visual arts, but are also raising the reputation of the department. The department offers BFA, MFA and 2 year Art Appreciation programmes and research work on Contemporary Indian and Western art forms. The department offers research programmes like Ph. D. and D. Lit.

### **Department of Sculpture**

In 1993 Department of Sculpture was established as an independent for specialization in three dimensional arts. This department has been offering BFA and MFA programmes since 1988 and 1995 respectively. Department focuses on practical aspects of 3D art techniques such as metal casting (bronze), stone carving, wood carving, terracotta, mixed media along with life study, head study and portrait, composition, piece mould and casting. It also imparts theoretical knowledge on ancient and modern history of art, modern sculpture, aesthetics and iconography of India & West.



The department runs BFA, MFA and Ph. D. programmes. The primary goal of the department is to educate students and make them capable to learn the art of effective visual communication. All students and teachers are actively engaged in intense academic exercises and research work.

### **Department of Graphics**



Established in the Year 1988, Department of Graphics is engaged in teaching Under Graduate B.F.A. and Post Graduate M.F.A. programmes Since 1993. The department is actively engaged in research activities through Ph. D. Programmes. Students are provided with the required freedom in shaping their ideas, while their own standpoints and artistic opinions are honed and stimulated through discussions with teachers.

Special focus is on the development of students' own independent grasp of printmaking. Maximum effort is made to encourage experimentation

with the broader field of visual arts that overlaps with other media. The curriculum at Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Ph. D. level emphasizes on creative thinking and intellectual awareness of the individual.

### **Department of Craft and Design**



Established in the year 2013, the Department of Craft & Design offers three years vocational degree Bachelor of Vocation (B. Voc.) program in Textile Design and Fashion Design. Apart from employability aspects of the programme, the objective of the department is to make the quality design education affordable. The program consists of theoretical studies, practical courses and guided design projects delivered through lectures, practical demonstrations. The program is rigorous in nature and demands student's maximum attendance and consistent efforts in completing the course work.

### **Department of History of Arts and Aesthetics**

Established in the year 2013, Department is focused on imparting education in History of Arts and Aesthetics. The department offers under graduate programme with objectives of imparting historical and theoretical knowledge, enlightening students with cultural rituals and traditions and providing new perspectives and directions for research scholars.

### Department of Sanskrit



The Department of Sanskrit, founded in the year 1971, is engaged in teaching of Sanskrit language in Under Graduate and Sanskrit literature in Post Graduate level(M.A.). The department is also actively engaged in inter-disciplinary research in Ph. D. and D. Lit. The department also offers one year Diploma in Functional Sanskrit.

### **Department of Hindi**

Department of Hindi was established in the year 1971. The department is involved in the teaching of Hindi Language to the students of BPA/BFA/B.Voc., Hindi Literature to the students of BPA. Hindi Literature to the students of M.A. Hindi. It also offers Post Graduate M.A. Hindi Programme an optional course on Functional Hindi is also offered to the students of BPA and BFA. The department has been consistently involved in research through Ph.D. and D.Lit Programmes. Students of the department have been placed in various colleges and universities not only in state but outside as well.



The Department also publishes the journal 'Vaagvibha' that contains creative contributions from students and research scholars.

### **Department of English**



Department of English was established in 1971. The Department offers postgraduate M.A. English programme and has also been actively involved in the teaching of English Language and Literature to the students of BPA, BFA and B.Voc. In addition the students are offered One Year Diploma and Advanced Diploma Course in Communicative English. The Department also offers Ph.D. and D.Lit. programme and has produced PhDs in diverse areas relating not only to English but other interdisciplinary domains. To cater the need of the students. A Department also runs a well equipped


out the Research Journal Literary Discourses (ISSN: 0976-2035). Department has a rich collection of published works by its faculty members.

### Department of Ancient Indian History, Culture & Archaeology

The department offers teachings for Under Graduate and Postgraduate programmes. It also offers Ph.D. and D. Lit. research programme. The University museum is managed by the department.



### **Department of Theatre**



Established in the year 2006, this Department offers Undergraduate, Postgraduate and One-Year Diploma programmes, as well as the facility for Ph.D. and D.Lit. This department gives special emphasis on the theoretical aspects of theatre and also encourages experiments. In order to enhance the natural talent of the students in the department, special training is provided on all the arts of theatre, such as acting, body movement, stage design, costume design, makeup, theatre music, direction, stage management, film acting and film making process. So that the students can be strengthened from the academic and professional point of view. Rang Mandal was

established by the department in the year 2022 to work towards experimentation in theatre and providing creative opportunities to the ex-students of the department and university. This experiment is a new experiment of its kind in the university structure. The productions of the department have been appreciated in important national theatre festivals of the country. The basic objective of the department is to create the qualities and skills of theatre within the students so that the students can progress in this field.

### **Department of Lifelong Learning**



Department of Lifelong Learning carries out a variety of lifelong learning programs at its centre as well as in the rural areas. Department regularly organizes workshops, seminars, special gatherings (sammelans), etc. to facilitate the necessary training to the rural society with an objective of holistic development of Indian Culture and Vocations. The department runs short term and long term programmes specially designed to help the rural people and to empower them to utilize the diverse resources at micro and macro level for self-reliance.

### Language Lab

The language Lab aims to develop language proficiency in the students and research scholars of the university, so as to contribute to their personality development and improve communication skills. The lab is equipped with language lab software, projector, whiteboard, computers, headphones and other e-learning materials and student friendly gadgets. The lab also helps to bridge the international language barriers. It has been of much use for both international and national students.





### Rajkumari Ushadevi Singh Library



Our University has a unique Library of Music, Dance, Folk Music and Visual Arts. Library has a rich collection of more than **45** thousand books, **2400**+ back volumes of research journals, more than **430** + thesis and **40**+ current journals. Library also has special section for visually challenged users. In this section we have brail literature, audio books, brail typewriter and printer with computer for visually challenged users.

Library has the membership of DELNET, which provides access to selected international full-text journals from various fields, including Arts. University has signed a MoU with IGNCA, New Delhi and INFLIBNET

Centre, Gandhinagar for NCAA project and Shodhganga, respectively.

Library provides Content Page Service (CPS) through e-mail to all the faculty members and research scholars. In this service the scanned copy of content page of every research journals subscribed is provided through email as soon as we receive it. On request we also provide scanned copy of whole article of these journals. Reprographic facility through photocopier and scanner is also provided to the students and research scholars. University Library, also the Knowledge Resource Centre of the University, has stocks of very rare books and transcripts of manuscripts which attracts research scholars of other institutions to visits our library to access the reading materials.

### **Audiovisual Section**

University has a rich collection of Audio Visual material which includes 1600+ Gramophone Records, 2900+ Audio Cassettes, Audio books for Blind Students, 300+ Spool Tapes, significant number of microfilms, video tapes, ACDs, VCDs etc. University signed a MoU with IGNCA as a partnering institution for the National Cultural Audiovisual Archieve (NCAA) project, in which audiovisual materials of our university is easily accessible to all.



### **Computer Centre**



The Computer Centre provides 100-Mbps internet connectivity under National Knowledge Network (NKN) Project via Local Area Network (LAN) and Wi-Fi in the University. With adequate number of computer systems for the students and researchers, Computer Centre conducts short term computer awareness/literacy programmes for all the students, researchers and University Staff. The Centre provides and shares necessary information pertaining to the IT and ITES.Centre helps students in gaining IT and ITES edge over their counterparts. The centre also provides classes to the research scholars studying Research Methodology.

### **Entertainment Hall**

As part of Students' academic life, University provides opportunity to the students to take a break from their study and in evening after study hours students can engage themselves in various indoor and outdoor sports activities. University has dedicated Entertainment Hall with necessary amenities to support indoor games like Carrom, Chess, Table Tennis etc.



### Museum



The renovated museum was inaugurated by Honorable Chief Minister of Chhattisgarh on 14<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2016. The museum is associated with the Department of Ancient Indian History Culture & Archaeology. It has number of archaeological remains and art pieces depicting vividly rich culture of Dakshin Kosala. The museum is fully documented and has successfully drawn the attention of the interested artists, learners, researchers and common visitors. A mini Classical & Folk Musical-Instrument Gallery always attracts the visitors. It has galleries: Painting Gallery, Archaeological Gallery, Sculpture Gallery, Folk Art Gallery, and Prehistoric Gallery.

### **Auditorium**

University has 3 different Indoor Auditoriums to cater different requirements of the Students. New Auditorium in the Campus II has seating capacity of approximately 600 persons, whereas 2 other auditoriums in Campus I – The Durbar Hall and Theatre Department have the capacity to accommodate more than 100 and 150 persons respectively. The Durbar Hall in the Campus I is situated in the donated palace and it still has the same aura as it was in the realm of the then Rulers of Khairagarh.



### **Yoga Centre**



Day by day competition is increasing in the modern world and so is stress in our lives. Often it is being observed that, it becomes very tough for us to meet the impeccable demand of the society. At Indira Kala Sangit Vishwavidyalaya we embark upon a journey of self-discovery and true bliss to overcome all the challenges of demanding and competitive modern lifestyle. The Yoga Centre is established to give relevant training in Yoga so that, our students and staff lead to a healthy and active lifestyle. It is one of the best known and effective forms of stress relief and helps students to

concentrate better on their respective academic programmes. Yoga Centre gives knowledge of various forms of Pranayamas and Asanas useful in developing physical and mental strength. The centre runs a diploma and a four month certificate course in Yoga.
























### **Admission Form**

Admission Form is available on the University website www.iksv.ac.in.

University adheres to the directives issued by Government of Chhattisgarh for the academic year 2023-24.

Applicant should carefully read all the rules and regulations regarding admission carefully before submitting the admission form. Applicants should fill the admission form only after ensuring that they have the necessary qualifications for admission. Applicant will be responsible for rejection of incomplete admission form. After successful submission of admission form, it is mandatory for applicant to attend the aptitude test to get admission in concerned programme.

On the basis of performance of the candidates the Departmental Admission Committee will declare the admission list and last date for submission of the required admission fee.

As per admission list selected candidates must complete all the formalities regarding admission till the last date. After completion of admission procedure students must attend the classes.

Except the students of the I year other students will be notified separately about the admission procedure and the last date of submission of admission fee.

- Admission procedure for Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Diploma 1<sup>st</sup> year will be starting from 15th June 2023 -30 June 2023
- First aptitude test for Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Diploma 1<sup>st</sup> year will be held between 12 to 15 July 2023 and result announced will be 15th July 2023 on. If needed the schedule of 2nd aptitude test will be announced separately.
- Date for admission procedure and fee submission for all semesters except 1st year will be announced separately.

A late fee of Rs. 100.00 per day will be applicable with fee after the due date of admission.

### **Age Limit**

As per the Department of Higher Education, Government of Chhattisgarh letter no. F 17-95/2017/38-2 dated 15.08.2021, the upper age limit for admission to all the programmes and courses have been relaxed.

### **Aptitude Test**

Elementary information related to their concerned subjects will be asked to the candidate during the aptitude test. Based on candidate's performances, merit list will be prepared and recommendations will be made.

### **Reservation & Relaxation**

This university has reserved seats for the applicants belonging to different categories in all degree and diploma courses as mentioned here under:

- 7. For the students, whose parents are transferred from other States to Chhattisgarh -10%
- 8. The percentage of reservation in each category is interchangeable.
- 9. In case due to certain reasons, if the allotted reserved quota remains vacant then it may be considered for allotment to the students from the General category.
- 10. Relaxation by 5% in minimum prescribed marks for admission will be given to the applicants from SC and ST category.
- 11. The following special relaxations for Kashmiri Migrant Students are given by the Govt. of India from 2006-07 and is also applicable for this University -
  - Extension in date of admission by about 30 days.
  - Subjected to the minimum eligibility requirement, relaxation in cut-off percentage up to 10%.
  - Course-wise increase in intake capacity will be up to 5%.
  - Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical/professional institution.
  - Waiving of domicile certificate.
  - Migrants will be provided with the facilities in second and subsequent years also.
  - Two Seats with respect to the overall seats will be reserved for the candidates from Jammu & Kashmir.
- 12. Reservation rules issued by Government from time to time will be implemented as it is.

### **Admission Restrictions**

- 1. University will not allow any such student for admission, whose conduct is not conducive to the traditions and academic environment of the University.
- 2. If required, the subject can be changed only once, with the approval of the concerned Head of Department of the main subject and the permission of the Head of Department of the changed subject. The time limit for changing the subject will be one month from the date of depositing the fee. After that no subject change will be permitted.
- 3. B.F.A., M.F.A., B.Voc. B.P.A. and M.A. courses are not available for private students/candidates.
- 4. In case if any diploma student has discontinued his studies in the middle of a session or failed in the examination, then the concern student will not be eligible for re-admission in the same course as a regular student. However, above is not applicable in the case of foreign/ NRI student.
- 5. A candidate having one masters degree will only be allowed to appear in another master's degree as a private candidate.
- 6. The procedure of ATKT in annual exam pattern will be based on university rules.
- 7. If any student is unable to complete the course in the given time period, then in the next session that student will not be given admission as a regular candidate. Every student (regular and private) has to complete the exam of diploma UG and PG level within a time period of five years compulsorily.
- 8. University accepts the degrees/diplomas/certificates awarded by the UGC/AIU recognized Universities and or institutions governed by the Government of India or the State Governments. A list in this regard is attached separately.
- 9. The handicapped/differently-abled applicants, whose abilities are not found suitable for the course applied for, shall not be considered.

### **Hostel Rules**

- 1. University has separate hostels for boys and girls within the campus. Both have their separate mess.
- 2. Admission to hostel shall be granted by a special committee constituted by the university
- 3. Hostel facility is not available for Diploma students
- 4. Students can utilize the available basic facilities provided by the University. University is not

- 6. Students have to enclose a medical fitness certificate from a Civil Surgeon/Registered Medical Practitioner before their admission in hostel
- 7. At the beginning of the session, University will be providing the electrical appliances like bulbs and tube-lights only once at the beginning of the session. Without permission, using any extra electrical/electronic gadgets in the Hostel is an offence for which a fine of Rs. 500.00 may be levied on the spot to the concerned student
- 8. On the recommendation of the Registered Medical Practitioner, University reserves all the right to expel any hosteller suffering from any contagious disease or otherwise
- 9. Hostellers are advised to take care of their belongings themselves.
- 10. Warden of girls' hostel reserves all the right to check the mails of hostellers
- 11. Girls residing in the hostel will be allowed to meet only those visitors who are authorized by their respective Parents/Guardian
- 12. Hostellers should take meals only in the Hostel Mess. Mess facility will be available only after payment of prescribed mess charge. Hostellers must pay their mess charges before **10**th of every month
- 13. All the hostellers must be present in their allotted rooms during the daily inspection by the hostel warden at 9.00 pm.
- 14. Main gate of the girls' hostel will be closed at 7.30 pm and boys' will be by 10.00 pm.
- 15. Without prior permission of the hostel warden, female hostellers are not allowed to go/stay out of the hostel after 7.30 pm.
- 16. Local students are not allowed to avail the hostel facility.
- 17. Unauthorized writing / scribbling on the walls are strictly prohibited.
- 18. Participation in ragging or abetting in any manner is strictly prohibited and punishable. Students may lodge their complaints regarding the above to the Proctor of the University on mobile 9407762788 or report to the Anti Ragging Cell of the University or may use National Anti Ragging Help Line Number 18001805522 or email on helpline@antiragging.in Anti Ragging Cell of University or help-line numbers displayed at prominent places across the University.
- 19. Hostellers should reside only in their allotted rooms.
- 20. In case of damage to any of the hostel properties, concern hosteller(s) will be charged with cash penalty for the same.
- 21. Hostellers are not allowed to leave or stay outside Khairagarh without permission of the hostel wardens.
- 22. Smoking and consuming Liquor/Drugs and any other materials prohibited under **COTPA** in the hostel is strictly prohibited and punishable.
- 23. Hostellers are strictly prohibited to participate in any kind of anti social and anti-national activities.
- 24. Hostellers should completely vacate their rooms after the end of the session and submit the keys of their rooms to the hostel warden before leaving.
- 25. The University reserves all the rights to amend the hostel rules.
- 26. Parents must be present with girls at the time of admission in the hostel.
- 27. University reserves the right to allot the hostel as per availability.
- 28. Hostel Warden may inspect any room at any time without prior intimation.

### **Code of Conduct**

- 1. All the students must adhere to the 'University Code of Conduct' and 'Anti Ragging Ordinance available with Proctor and Dean of Students Welfare.
- 2. Ragging, inside or outside the campus, is strictly prohibited and considered as a punishable offence. - 4. A Proctorial-Board, (consisting of three senior university teachers, two senior students, two guardians, Proctor, Dean of Students Welfare, and Wardens of Girls' and Boys' Hostels) is constituted especially for the purpose of vigilance and recommendation of disciplinary actions.
- 5. University has constituted Anti Ragging Cells as per the Norms and Guidelines of the UGC for curbing the menace of Ragging in Institution of Higher Learning in India.
- 6. For any anti-disciplinary act or misconduct of the students, inside or outside the university campus, disciplinary actions including suspension, expulsion, debarring from appearing in the examinations and rustication etc. will be taken on the recommendation of the Proctorial Board.
- 7. Students are expected to attend the classes in professional attires.
- 8. Smoking and consuming Liquor/Drugs in the campus is strictly prohibited and is a punishable offence.
- 9. In case of any dispute relating to admission/qualification/fee/reservation/age limit etc., decision Of the University shall be deemed final.

### **Examination**

- 1. Students must have at least 75% (Seventy Five Percent) attendance in the concerned course, failing which the concerned student shall be barred from appearing in the examination. Under special circumstance and upon the recommendation of the Head of the Department, the Vice-Chancellor may allow maximum relaxation of 15% (Fifteen Percent) on the above.
- 2. With the special permission of the Vice -Chancellor and on payment of the prescribed examination fees, examination forms of Regular or Private candidates may be accepted before 45 days from the commencement of the concerned examination.
- 3. The application for revaluation must reach the university within 30 days from the receipt of the mark sheet after declaration of result.
- 4. No foreign/NRI student is allowed to appear in any examination as an external/private candidate.
- 5. Without obtaining prior permission from this university, if any foreign/NRI student is found to have appeared in any other examination, from an institution which is not associated with IKSV then in such case the concerned student would be barred from appearing in the university examinations.
- 6. Medium of writing in the examination is Hindi or English only.
- 7. For admission in Post Graduate programmes candidate must have:
  - a. Minimum 45% aggregate marks in the qualifying degree exam.
  - b. Minimum aggregate of 50 % in the concerned qualifying programme.
  - c. Necessary reservation policy will be applicable to the concerned candidates

### **General Facilities**

- 1. Students facing any kind difficulties in communication or otherwise due to languages may join special classes for spoken English/Hindi language.
- 2. Students may avail special Railway concession for study tours as per the rules of Indian Railways.
- 3. Girls having domicile of Chhattisgarh State and any student belonging to Schedule Cast, Schedule Tribe (Chhattisgarh State) are exempted from payment of tuition fees for graduate and post graduate courses.
- 4. Wards of University Employees and Daily wagers (continuously working for more than five years) are exempted from payment of tuition fees for Diploma, Graduate and Post graduate courses.
- 5. Visually impaired students of Chhattisgarh State are exempted from payment of tuition fees, examination fees and hostel room rents (Please see regulation no. XXIV). However, refundable caution money has to be deposited by the concern student.
- 6. Differently-abled students (other than visually impaired) of Chhattisgarh are exempted from Examination fees only.
- 7. As per the university rules, visually impaired students are provided with writer and extra time during the written examinations of the University.
- 8. After getting the regular admission, Student must submit the library membership application form for availing Library facility of the University. On the basis of the application form, library membership card will be issued to the student. Books are issued through University Library Card only.
- 9. Candidate with ICCR scholarship will be exempted from the University Aptitude test for admission.
- 10. As per the directives of UGC, the eligible SC/ST/OBC, Specially/differentially-abled students etc. should submit their scholarship form with in the due date to respective department for the academic year for processing scholarship.
- 11. The University has established a gym (gymnasium) in campus 1 since 2014 and it was refurbished in 2021 and equipped with advanced technology equipments and also has a instructor who gives training to the students.


